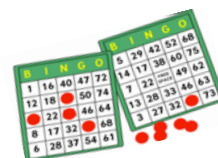

Here's what we do ...

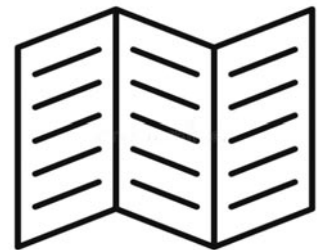
