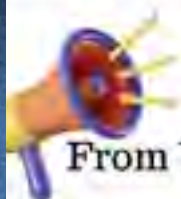

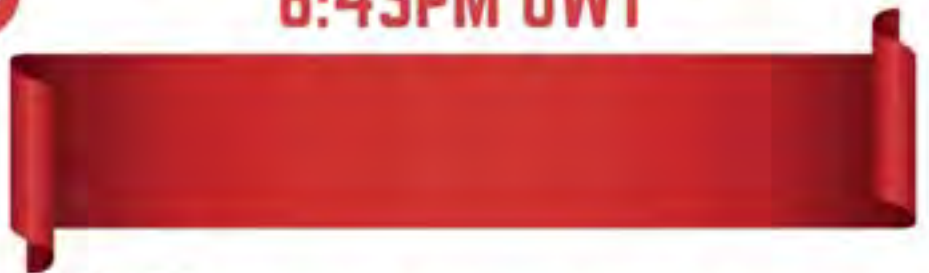

Climate Change, Wisconsin, and What We Can Do

Presented by Andrew Westgate

Human-caused climate change poses an existential threat to the global community. However, not all regions will be affected in the same way. While Wisconsin is considered one of the best places to be with respect to climate change impacts, it will still experience changes in temperature and precipitation. While this seems overwhelming, there are different steps we can take to minimize the effects of climate change and create a better future.

Presenter Bio: Andrew Westgate is a PhD student in UWM's atmospheric sciences focusing on climate dynamics. He received his B.S. in atmospheric sciences at Northern Vermont University - Lyndon before moving to Wisconsin to start his M.S. degree. He is also the UWM Graduate Student Representative for The Climate Consensus, an organization that seeks to bridge the gap between scientists and non-scientists about human-caused climate change. He is originally from southern Massachusetts.
